Position Description

The Native Seed Specialist works with the Heritage Growers' team (a venture of River Partners) and the River Partners science team to efficiently contribute to the process of native seed collection. The wildland seed collection process includes obtaining permission to collect, performing pre-collection field surveys, monitoring for ripeness, seed collection, seed conditioning, seed testing, managing seed inventory, collected and processed to support Heritage Growers seed amplification, nursery production and seed sales processes. Flexibility, creativity, and problem-solving skills are required to determine the most efficient and effective method to identify, monitor and collect wildland seed. The position requires good field botanical skills to



determine species, when seed is ripe and ready to collect, and careful documentation of the collection process. The spring-fall seed collection period will require approximately 50-75% of work time dedicated to travel and fieldwork. This position also performs data collection for Heritage Growers native seed germination trail research projects and some seed cleaning. Office responsibilities of the Native Seed Specialist primarily include seed collection data management, development of seed collection maps, protocols and reporting. The Native Seed Specialist is also expected to assist with other administrative duties as needed.

Essential Functions and Responsibilities

- Conduct pre-collection botany surveys of several locations in the Central Valley and potentially other areas
- Monitoring seed for ripeness and determination of seed fill
- Perform seed collections
- Manage collected field material
- Assist in native seed germination trial research and data collection
- Develop seed collection maps using ArcGIS
- Work with the Heritage Gowers team to write annual reports for various funders
- Build protocols for native seed collection and cleaning processes
- Assistance with data management and Heritage Growers administrative tasks
- Ability to work independently under the guidance of the Heritage Growers management team
- Detailed record keeping
- Clear communication across many teams and stakeholders
- Other assignments as requested to achieve seed collection goals
